2017 BARREL SADDLE SERIES

RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. Series is open to anyone who pays their entry fees. Members or non-members of PRC.
2. A one-time \$25/per rider series entry fee paid must be paid by anyone who would like to run for the Saddle. Anyone may enter the PRC races without paying the \$25 registration fee and compete for day money. A rider will not be considered eligible for the saddle, prizes & points until the \$25 registration fee has been paid.
3. This series will be approved first by BCBRA (British Columbia Barrel Racing Association), and co-approved by BRN4D (Barrel Racers National 4D) the CBR (Canadian Barrel Racing) and the ABRA (Alberta Barrel Racing Association). All races will run under the BCBRA rules as that is the first approving/sanctioning association.
4. Only the OPEN RACES will count toward the saddle series.
5. Eligible race dates are the following Sundays:
 - a. April 30, 2017 After Gymkhana (approx. 3:30pm)
 - b. May 28, 2017 After Gymkhana (approx. 3:30pm)
 - c. July 1, 2017 Canada Day – (With Team Roping)
 - d. July 2, 2017 Canada Day – (With Team Roping)
 - e. July 30, 2017 After Gymkhana (approx. 3:30pm)
 - f. August 27, 2017 After Gymkhana (approx. 3:30pm)
 - g. October 1, 2017 After Gymkhana (approx. 3:30pm)
6. The 2014 Saddle Series Point System will be as follows:

And so on down so every rider earns 1 point for entering
7. There is no a minimum or maximum number of races to attend. It will be up to the riders to get as many points as possible over the season's 8 races and the rider with the most points wins. The more races entered the higher the potential to earn points. All PRC Races will count including any possible dates added as the season progresses.
8. Points will be accumulated on a rider. But a rider may register more than one horse to be eligible for prizes. A rider may ride as many horses as they choose. If a rider places on more than one horse, the riders' highest point earning horse will be horse #1; the second highest point earning horse will be horse #2 and so on.
9. Highpoint at end of series will win the saddle. There will be five runner-up prizes for 2nd to 6th place finishers in the Series. Saddle and any other prizes will be awarded at the end of the last race. Winners must be present to receive saddle or prizes will go to the next riders in line. Winners must be in full western attire for sponsor photos or saddle and/or other prizes will go to the next rider in line. Western attire
10. In the case of a tie for the saddle at the end of the series, a run-off will be held. After the run-off, whoever runs closest to their time of that final race date will be determined the winner of the saddle. If there is still a tie after the run-off, the second tie will be determined by whoever ran in the run-off the closest to their fastest time of the season. All ties for 2nd to 6th place awards will be by a coin flip.
